Skills Learnt	Ingenuity, competition,
Why do we like it?	It's hard when you have to hold your leg or your foot
Where does it come from?	Argentina

How to play: Someone is chosen as the snake to chase everyone, the others all run away. If the snake catches someone they have to keep on running but holding onto the part of the body where the snake "poisoned" you making it difficult to keep running. For example if the snake touches you on your feet you have to keep on running with one leg holding onto your foot. The game finishes when everybody but one person is poisoned and they are the winner.



Red letter

Number of players	6 plus
Equipment	None
Skills Learnt	Knowing the letters of the alphabet, listening skills, concentration, Learning English
Why do we like it?	Trying to get to the end first
Where does it come from?	Ireland

How to play: One child is chosen to call out letters. The others all stand in a line. First the caller decides on the Red Letter and calls it out. If you move on this letter you have to go back to the beginning. Then the caller shouts out letters. If you have that letter in your name you can take a step towards the caller. If a letter is in your name twice you can take two steps and so on.

The winner is the first person to reach the caller.
